

Assessing Project Management Knowledge

PM Knowledge Test



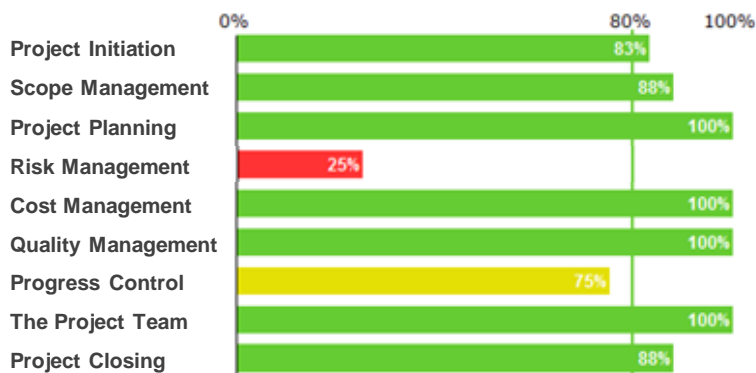
In certain situations it might be useful to assess the knowledge of project management of project managers or team members. Either prior to training in order to determine the participants' training needs more specifically, or to assess the current knowledge of project teams members or employees in view of staff assignments.

PM Knowledge Test is designed as a first step in the project management learning process and comprises a set of questions and problems related to managing projects.

The tool can be used for preliminary tests, as well as at the end of a training to conduct final tests (similar to the preliminary test) in order to assess the acquisition of new knowledge.

The test is based on fundamental knowledge required to manage projects – not only in the execution phase of a project, but also in initiation, planning and closing phases.

The results of the test are then displayed according to the following knowledge areas:



This online test evaluates the project management knowledge of the participant (and allows him/her to become aware of his/her own knowledge).

The analysis of the results of the test allows evaluating the training needs as well as the definition of goals.



PM Knowledge Test is available online. Participants have to answer 60 questions and the duration of the test is 1 hour.
