



## ASSESSMENT TOOL PM SKILL TEST

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## FEATURES

Most project management tests and assessments measure one thing: knowledge.

While knowledge is certainly useful to evaluate the know-how, it cannot exclusively tell you if someone is a good project manager. You also need to know how they might cope with problems or difficult situations.

*PM Skill Test* is the solution to evaluate in a cost-effective way the technical and managerial competencies of your project managers.

*PM Skill Test* consists of 50 problems and difficult situations typically encountered during the day-to-day running of a project. For each situation, four options are suggested (i.e. four different ways of solving the problem). The aim is to assess the pertinence of each option and sort them in order of preference.

The test is based on the competencies required to be a project manager – not only in the execution phase of a project, but also in the initiation, planning and closing phases. Besides technical know-how, the test will also measure the soft skills needed to be a project manager.



The tool is available in different languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Dutch, Russian, Portuguese, Vietnamese and Chinese.

## AUDIENCE

### Target group:

- Experienced project managers those who would like to evaluate their managerial and leadership qualities.
- Project managers that would like to learn the strengths and weaknesses in their soft skills.
- Companies that would like to evaluate the managerial and leadership qualities of project managers for training or other purposes.

## DURATION AND PDU'S

After completing the test, participants immediately receive the results and a graph showing where they encountered difficulties and which percentage of correct answers they gave.
