THE LECTURER HAS AN ACTIVE ROLE

e-Learning: Students who learn the theory in self-study at the beginning of a cursus, allow a common level of knowledge early on. And the students are accompanied by a tutor.

Tutor: During this phase, the trainer can accompany and motivate the students, reply to their questions, and correct their self-replies within the learning system. STS provides every trainer using our e-Learning tools with a free coach/tutor access so that he/she can be there for students. After this first, self-learning phase, the trainees have a sound knowledge of project management what leads to more practical and applied teaching (case studies, serious games, hands-on exercises etc.) during instructor-led sessions.

e-Learning licenses are valid for 1 year.

SimulTrain[®] is a multi-media Project Management serious game which allows the trainees to experience – within a few hours – typical situations and challenges encountered in most projects. Each team of 3-4 participants runs, in the role of its Project Manager, a midsize project in an accelerated mode. Various situations arise during the simulation, which require





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fast decision-making. However, decisions must take into account all the project parameters, i.e. cost, schedule, quality, but also the human factors. SimulTrain can be played in a classroom or virtually.

The trainer has an active role, he explains the simulation to students, monitors the group sessions, intervenes as the project sponsor and does debriefing sessions. STS offers free online SimulTrain Train-the-Trainer sessions. For dates check out our <u>website</u>. Afterwards trainers can request a free password to experience SimulTrain in detail, as well as a personal Trainer Desk account for managing their sessions. One SimulTrain password is valid for one unique full simulation within 1 year.

PRICING FOR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

STS supports education and is pleased to grant a special academic price for state schools and state universities. This price is granted on the twofold condition that the students must 1) be registered in initial (or vocational) training, for at least one year and that 2) the budget of the school must be controlled by the state. This price does not apply to any continuing (or executive) educational training.

STS has several price lists according to geographical region and currency.
